VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

Please note: Effective 20/11/20

Maryvale Private Hospital has implemented the following visitor restrictions, to ensure the safety of our patients and staff.

This is in line with the recommendations from Victorian Department of Health and Human Services, and our patient room capacity.

All Visitors

- **All visitors** to the hospital must be **signed in and signed out** at the front Concierge Desk
- **All visitors** must complete the COVID-19 questionnaire
- **All visitors** must undergo a temperature check
- **Any visitor** with a temperature above 37.5 degrees or refusal to have their temperature taken will be excluded from entering the hospital
- **All visitors** MUST wear a face mask

Visitors of Inpatients

- **One visitor at any one time** for up to two hours.
Maximum of two visitors per day
- Visiting hours are now strictly **3pm to 6pm**

Child (under 18 years of age) Day Patient Visitors

- One support person per child can stay with the child but must remain in the patients allocated bed cubicle

Please be kind to our Reception staff who are enforcing these restrictions in the best interests of our already vulnerable patients and valuable staff.
