Surgical Site Infection:

Surgical site infections are one of the most common complications associated with surgery and can lead to devastating consequences, including lifelong morbidity and mortality. However, these infections are largely preventable.

A range of precautions undertaken before, during and after surgery can significantly reduce your risk of surgical site infection.

Whilst advances have been made in infection control practices including improved operating room ventilation, sterilisation methods, barriers, surgical technique, and appropriate use of antibiotics, there are also important things you can do to significantly reduce your risk.

What can I do to prevent Surgical Site Infection:

Before surgery:

- · Give up smoking
- · Maintain a healthy weight
- Optimise blood sugar control if you have diabetes
- Don't shave near where you will have surgery for at least five days before your surgery
- Perform decolonisation of your skin and nose. Decolonisation means to remove common bacteria that normally live on body sites that have been shown to be the cause of most surgical site infections. A decolonisation body wash and nasal gel named Octenisan are available for purchase at Maryvale Private Hospital. These products are to be used for five days before your surgery. The cost of these products is \$35 total if picked up from the hospital, or they can be posted for an extra \$15.

After surgery:

- Mobilise and get out of bed as soon as recommended by your doctor
- For most surgeries, wound dressings should stay dry and not be removed until your post discharge doctor appointment
- Always keep your hands clean with either an alcohol-based handrub or soap and water. Note: if your hands are visibly dirty use soap and water

Your decolonisation bundle will contain the following products:

Antibacterial cleanser to help reduce the bacterial load that naturally reside on the surface of healthy skin. octenisan® wash lotion can be used for the whole body including the face, hair and scalp. Follow the instructions provided for body washing ensuring contact on the skin for at least 1 minute.



Wash the whole body paying particular attention to the armpits, genital area, anal region and buttocks.

Nasal gel to help decontaminate the nasal passages. Follow directions for use for octenisan® MD nasal gel, or as advised by your doctor or health care professional.

Instructions for use:

Octenisan MD nasal gel Use twice daily





Apply a sufficient quantity of nasal gel onto a cotton swab.



Apply the gel onto all surfaces of the nasal passage.



Spread the gel by gently compressing the nostrils. Remove any excess gel.

Take care not to insert the cotton swab too deeply into the nose.
